

# Student-Friendly Organization Rubric

(Expository)

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- My introduction will catch your eye.
- My main idea really stands out.
- Details go together.
- Wow! What an ending.
- Clear! Easy to follow! (my transitions show the way)

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- You could miss my MAIN point, if you didn't pay attention.
- You might need to read it twice to follow it.
- Oops! How did this detail get in here?
- My transitions often work well; however, sometimes they are too obvious or too weak for someone trying to follow my thinking.

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- An introduction? Heck—I just started in.
- What does the reader need to know first?
- I'm not sure what goes with what—HELP!
- An ending? I just stopped!
- Details are jumbled.
- My transitions may be missing or confusing.
