 <p><i>Idea Development</i></p> <p>Like the foundation of a house, IDEA DEVELOPMENT serves as the solid base on which a good piece of writing rests.</p>			
 <p>ORGANIZATION</p> <p>Just as a house has an entrance, an exit, hallways that connect, and a sensible layout, so too does a piece of good writing.</p>			
 <p>Voice</p> <p>The author's VOICE— a.k.a. you!—should be present in every piece of writing you make. Good WORD CHOICE can help you improve your voice!</p>			
 <p>CONVENTIONS</p> <p>The roof of a house— though planned from the beginning—is not built first. Think about CONVENTIONS near the end of your process. And remember...thoughtful SENTENCE FLUENCY can have an impact on your conventions score!</p>
