all!"



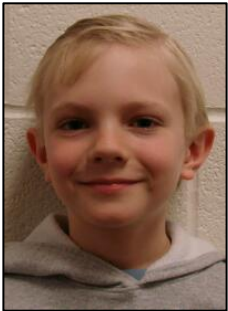
